Ten Plagues

Scripture to read: Exodus 7,8 chapter

The Lord strengthened Moses and told him to; tell everything that the Lord commanded him. The first Plague, _Aaron raised his staff and struck the water of the Nile. Suddenly, the whole river turned to blood! The fish in the river died, and the water became foul. The Second plague, frogs across the entire land.
