The feast of Passover

Scripture to read: Exodus 12 chapter

Before the tenth plague took place, the Lord gave the following instructions to Moses and Aaron: "From now on, this month will be the first month of the year for you. Announce to the whole community of Israel that on the tenth day of this month each family must choose a lamb or a young goat for a sacrifice, one animal for each household. The animal you select must be a one-year-old male, either a sheep or a goat, with no defects. "Take special care of this chosen animal until the evening of the fourteenth day of this first month. Then the whole assembly of the community of Israel must slaughter their lamb or young goat at twilight. They are to take some of the blood and smear it on the sides and top of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the animal and then they should eat it, those who are not Israelites should not eat it. On that night, I will pass through the land of Egypt and strike down every firstborn son and firstborn male animal in the land of Egypt. This plague of death will not touch the houses were blood is speared on the doorposts. The feast that is celebrated in this way is called Passover.





What little ones, have you ever celebrated the feast of Passover? You'll have started to wonder...or is your answer, No... No... No, we have not celebrated at all? Yes, what you told was correct. Our Lord Jesus Christ died for us as a lamb without blemish before two thousand years ago, That's the reason we don't celebrate the feast of Passover. The blood that was smeared on the doorposts of the Israelites saved them from destruction. In the same way, our Lord Jesus Christ shed his blood and sacrificed himself for us. That blood saves us even today. Now instead of eating the flesh, we should read the word of God every day and know the truth. Can we thank our Lord Jesus Christ for delivering us from our sins? Just like our Lord Jesus who loved us and delivered us, let us also tell others about Jesus and deliver them from their sins.

"On the fourteenth day of the first month, you must celebrate the Lord's Passover. Numbers 28:16
