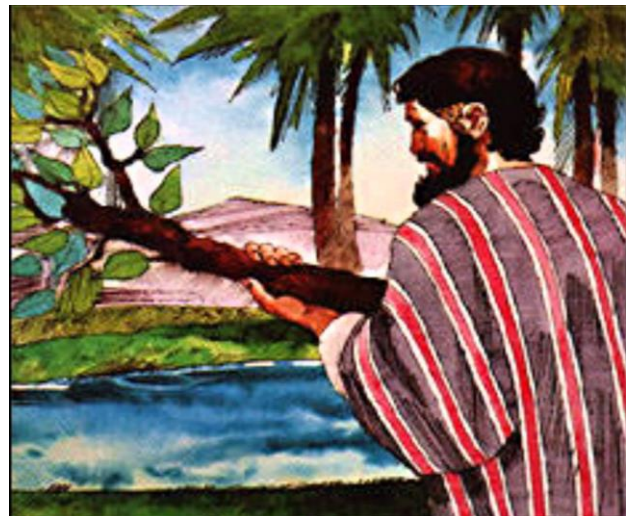

Marah

Scripture to read: Exodus 15 chapter

Then Moses led the people of Israel away from the Red Sea, they traveled in the desert for three days without finding any water. There was no water in the desert. When they came to the oasis of Marah, the water was too bitter to drink. So, they called the place Marah. Then the people complained and turned against Moses. "What are we going to drink?" they demanded. So, Moses cried out to the Lord for help, and the Lord showed him a piece of wood. Moses threw it into the water, and this made the water good to drink. It was there at Marah that the Lord set before them the following decree, he said, "If you will listen carefully to the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in his sight, obeying his commands and keeping all his decrees, then I will not make you suffer any of the diseases I sent on the Egyptians; for I am the Lord who heals you."
