When God is With Us...!

The servant of Pharaoh who was released from the prison was set back to work in the king's office, but he did not remember Joseph. For the next two years, Joseph was a blessing to many in the prison. Question:

What was the main reason for the victory of Joseph?

Answer:

The core reason for the success of Joseph was God being with him at all times. This might push us to question, 'Is not God with me at all times'? To be honest, many a times God is not with us. It is not that God has forsaken us, rather we have forsaken God.

1) Do we praise God only during good times or even during tough times?

2) Do we trust Him only in abundance or even during times of lack?

3) Do we fear God during sinful temptations?

4) Do we exalt God at all places without exalting ourselves?

When we fail to do these things, we separate ourselves from God and therefore experience failure, pain and suffering.
