When Joseph revealed himself to his brothers, they realized that God has fulfilled the dream that he gave Joseph and now he was in authority over them. They were all fearful of what Joseph might do to them. But Joseph understanding their hearts said unto them that it was God who was in control of all that happened. God had planned all of this to protect the family from the famine that was to come. He sent them to immediately bring along the entire family of Jacob from the land of Canaan. Question:

Can God turn out the evil for goodness even in our lives?

Answer:

If Joseph didn't love God:

- 1) He would have murmured in the pit and would've been destroyed there.
- 2) He would have sinned with the wife of Potiphar and therefore would've been defeated by sin.

It was the love he had for God that protected him and exalted him in authority over the land of Egypt. The love we have for God will not just lead us into holiness but also into abundant blessings.
