Leviticus

Scripture to read: Leviticus 10, 19th chapter

In the Holy Bible, Leviticus is the third book. Moses was the author of this book. He has told the importance of the worship of the Lord and the manner of how to worship him. Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu were working in the Tabernacle. They disobeyed the Lord by burning before him the wrong kind of fire, different than he had commanded. The Lord had already told, you must be Holy because I, the Lord your God, am Holy. In the same way, when you come to know about others sickness, you should also pray fervently for them.
