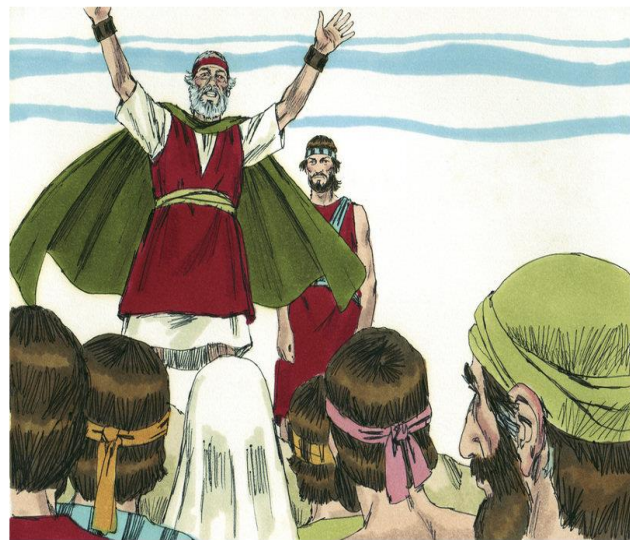
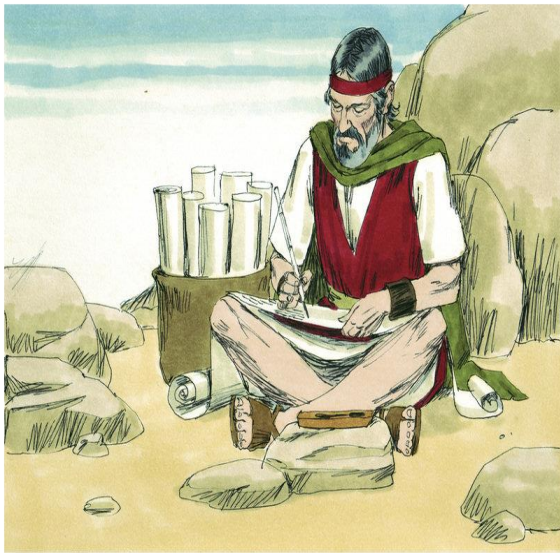

Deuteronomy

Scripture to read: Deuteronomy 6: 1-12

Deuteronomy is the fifth book written by Moses. Through this book, Moses reminds the people of Israel about all that the Lord had done for them and all the decrees and commands that he gave them. After which Moses died without entering Canaan the Promised Land. When Moses knew about his death, he prepared Joshua to lead the people of Israelites and then blessed the people saying, the Lord reminds you again and again, "You and your children and grandchildren must fear the Lord your God as long as you live. If you obey all his decrees and commands and if you want to enjoy a long life, "you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength".
