Question:

It is important for us to constantly search our hearts and be cautious to not allow such sins in our life. We should not allow the works of the flesh to rule over us. Since the brothers of Joseph gave place to envy in their hearts, the devil could easily rule over them. What happened to the promise of God, the prayers of Jacob and the dream of Joseph? We shall see it tomorrow!
