**Three Kings who went to meet Elijah**

**Scripture to read: 2Kings 3:1-18**

King Mesha of Moab waged war against Israel, during this time Joram son of Ahab was ruling over Israel. To protect Israel, Joram asked for help from Jehoshaphat king of Judah and from the King of Edom. All these three Kings gathered together to fight against the King of Moab. At the end of seven days after leaving for battle there was no water to drink for the soldiers and for the animals. But Jehoshaphat the King of Judah advised to enquire the prophet of the Lord before going to battle, and they went to meet Elisha. Elisha said to the king of Israel, "Why do you want to involve me? Go to the prophets of your father and the prophets of your mother." Then he told that it is only because of Jehoshaphat the King of Judah I will inquire of the Lord. He asked the harpist to play the harp and while the harpist was playing, the hand of the Lord came on Elisha and he said, "This is what the Lord says: I will fill this valley with pools of water. You will see neither wind nor rain, yet this valley will be filled with water, and you, your cattle and your other animals will drink.



My dear children are you thinking that the prophecy of Elisha came to pass or not? Without wind and rain how will the valley be filled with water? Is there anything impossible with our God? To the valley they dug, there it was—water flowing from the direction of Edom and the land was filled with water. When the Moabites got up early in the morning, the water looked red—like blood. If somebody comes to us asking for help, food and water we should help them. We should tell and pray that Jesus alone can help and perform miracles. God will exactly do whatever he has told.
