Elisha's Death

Elisha died due to his sickness. When Elisha came to know that Elijah was about to be taken into heaven, he stayed with him and did not leave him. He asked and received a double portion of blessing from Elijah. When Elisha was in his death bed, King Jehoash who was with him was also troubled. Even Gehazi his servant was filled with greed spoke lies and was cursed by Elisha and was stuck with leprosy. If Gehazi would have been truthful and feared God, if he would have asked for the double portion of anointing like Elisha. Elisha would have desired to bless him with the spiritual gift and God also would have granted him the same.

What happened after Elisha's death?

Once when some Israelites were burying a man, they hastily threw the corpse into the tomb of Elisha and fled. But as soon as the body touched Elisha's bones, the dead man revived and jumped to his feet! Such a great miracle, May God's name be glorified. Even after his death, miracle took place. Elisha died and gave life to a man. It is God who does miracles. And it is he who fills us with his power to do miracles. But people should desire and ask God. Dear Children please read and see the lessons of Elisha again. Elisha helped many people who were in need. He did not desire anything for him. Never ever be like Gehazi. Lend a helping hand to others who are in need as much as possible. Know the need of people and pray fervently for them every day.
