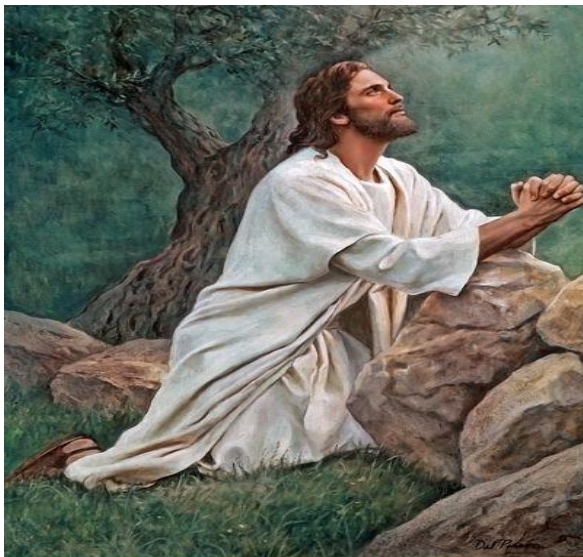


**July: 23**

**Jesus chosen disciples among the disciples.**

**Scripture reading: mark 3: 13-19**

After Jesus took baptism and defeated Satan in the wilderness, HE started proclaiming about the kingdom of God to the people. So there came lots of people to become HIS disciples and began to follow HIM where ever HE went. One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. A large crowd of his disciples was there and a great number of people from all over Judea, from Jerusalem, and from the coastal region around Tyre and Sidon, who had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. Those troubled by impure spirits were cured, and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.

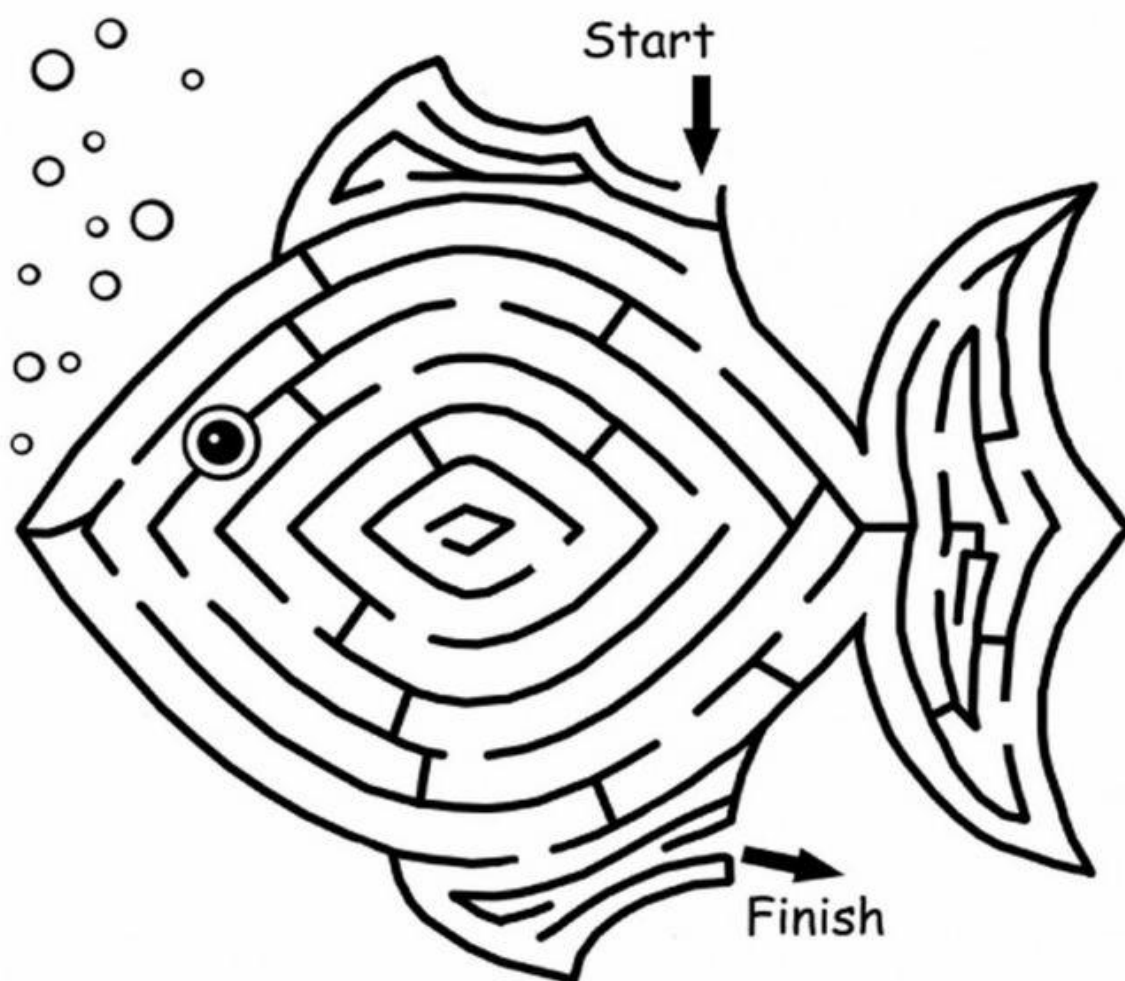
