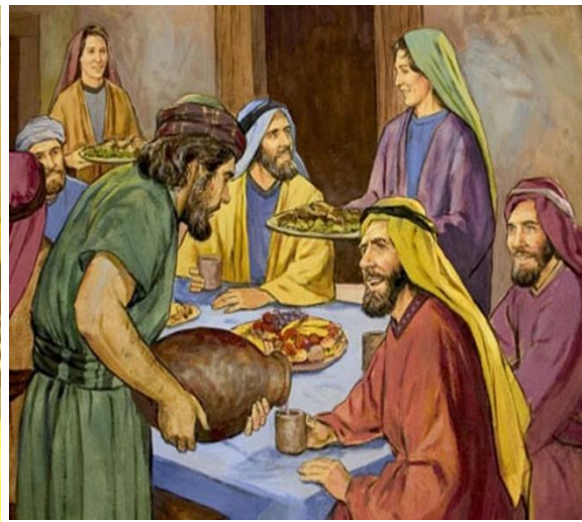
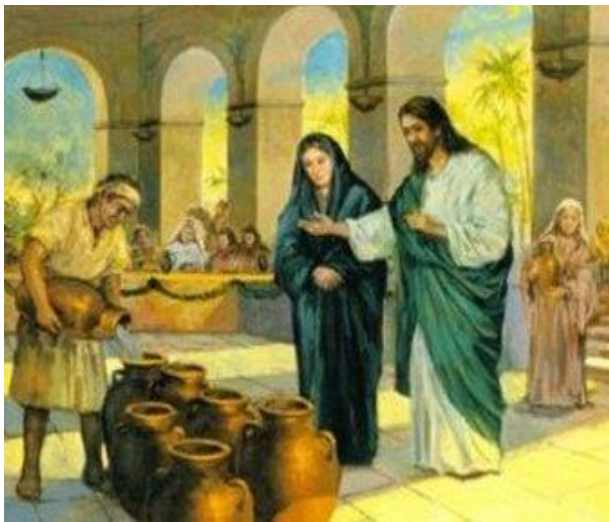

Water turn into wine in the Hand of Jesus.

Scripture reading: john 2:1-10

On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus mother was there, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine was gone, Jesus mother said to him, "They have no more wine." "Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." They did so, and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside and said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now."



Hey...., After Jesus began HIS ministry, this is the first exciting and joyful miracle HE performed. Jesus started using HIS Godly power for HIS ministry. Even though HE did it and HE could do it because HE is God, there is some external human factor played an important role in this incident for this miracle to take place? It is not formula for the miracle but it is the key for receiving miracles from Jesus even now. As usual I could found three points. They are

1. Our Lord Jesus was invited for this wedding. So the first step for miracle in any situation, we must invite Jesus in to all the area of life.
2. When HIS mother Mary told HIM about wine shortage, Jesus simply said MY time had not come. This teach us, there is nothing wrong to ask someone to pray for you. But it is better to ask yourself for you. And more over, it's important to wait for HIM and HIS time.
3. Mary said to the people of that house do what Jesus says. And then Jesus asked them to fill the jars with water. Even though everyone knows that it will take three days to prepare a good wine, they did not ask any question, but just obeyed. This is the final key for miracle. Obeisance with faith. Hope you would have enjoyed today's meditation. Shall we pray now at heart.....?

This miraculous sign at Cana in Galilee was the first time Jesus revealed his glory. And his disciples believed in him. John 2:11
