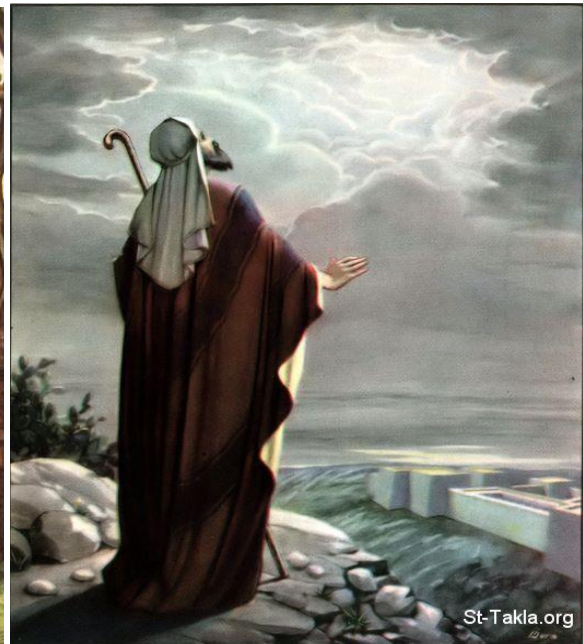
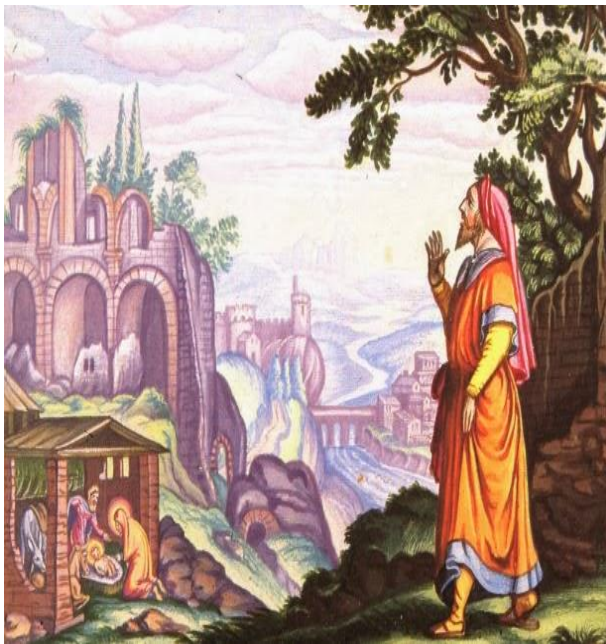

scripture reading: book of Micah
