Scripture Reading: Psalms 18:1 to 19:14

We have seen rocks. We cannot move it from its place. Hills are like small mountains, even they cannot be shaken. For ages, they remain in the same place. Our God is a rock. Rocks are symbolic of power and protection. We who cling on to Him will also become like Him.
