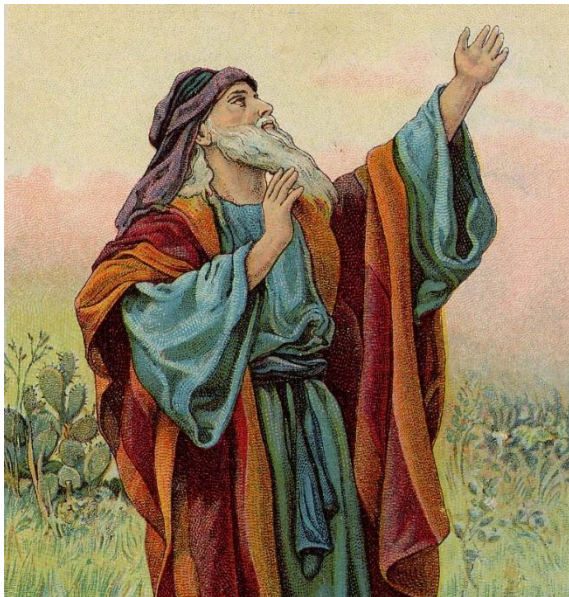

### Whom shall I send?

#### Scripture Reading: Isaiah 6:1-8

Isaiah chapter 6 is a description of the vision that prophet Isaiah saw. He saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His *robe* filled the temple. Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!" When Isaiah saw this, he cried out saying, "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I *am* a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, The Lord of hosts." Then one of the seraphim flew to Isaiah, having in his hand a live coal *which* he had taken with the tongs from the altar. And the seraphim touched his mouth *with it*, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged."



What dear children, are you'll amazed? Won't it be exciting if God even gives us the privilege to have such visions? Isaiah was a truthful man. As soon as he saw the Holiness of God, he confessed his sins. Even when you are truthful and when you earnestly desire for Holiness, God will fulfill your desires. In this situation God asked Isaiah, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Isaiah responded, "Here *am* !! Send me." Isaiah who had the call of God over his life, stood in his calling throughout his life. Dear children, God who called Isaiah will call you too. Will you surrender yourself for that higher calling?
